

Foreman: English 10 R Enduring Understandings

1. Students will understand how knowledge of roots, parts of speech, and context clues will help them define unfamiliar words in text, without running to a dictionary.
2. Students will understand how a use of text structure can help them to take effective notes.
3. Students will understand that they must draw conclusions based on inference or implicit text information as well as explicit text information.
4. Students will understand text better because they can analyze and interpret the theme or message of the text.
5. Students will understand text better because they can appreciate and analyze the use of simile, metaphor, pun, irony, symbolism, allusion and personification.
6. Students will understand that examining connections between texts, self, and world will help them in developing correct assumptions and perceptions of the world around them.
7. Students will understand that using leads, details, transitions, conclusions, personal experience, facts, anecdotes, examples, and paraphrased ideas will enhance their written communication.
8. Students will understand that the correct use of commas and semi-colons will enhance the meaning of their written communication.
9. Students will understand that being able to formulate their own questions is an important step to exploring and learning about important problems or issues.
10. Students will understand that accuracy and relevance of information will help them in analyzing multiple points of view or performing research.
